Speech and Language Impairment in Children

The Royal College of General Practitioners has launched an online training course for speech and language impairment.

It is essential for primary care professionals to be able to recognise when a child has significant speech and language impairment, to understand when to refer and to be aware of the impact this can have on the child's development and on the family.

After completing this course, practitioners should:

- Feel confident in recognising speech and learning impairment
- Understand what is typical in terms of speech and language development
- Understand when to refer
- Be aware of common causes of speech and language impairment

The Prescribing of Sodium Chloride

Please can we raise awareness around prescribing of sodium chloride for line flushes following a number of incidents reported by LCH community nurses. Some patients requiring Sodium chloride 0.9% solution for injection for line flushes have been prescribed and dispensed Sodium Chloride 0.9% Irrigation Solution. This only became apparent when the nurse visited to flush the line and was unable to do so because the patient had been supplied with the incorrect product. The community nurses on their part have been reminded to always make it clear which prod-
